

**VILLAGE DISTRICT OF EIDELWEISS
COMMISSIONERS MEETING**

May 18, 2010

The Board of Commissioners met on Tuesday, May 18th, 2010 at the District Office and traveled throughout the District to view road issues. Present were Commissioners Gloria Aspinall and Art Tucker. Also present was Wendall Dicey(Highway). The meeting was not taped.

Oak Ridge Road: The area above the 'S' turns was viewed. The broken pavement needs to be cleaned up. The ditch and swale also need to be worked. Wendall Dicey advises use of stone in the swale once cleaned to direct water into the woods. The water currently is blocked by the debris in the ditch and swale and therefore is undermining that portion of pavement. The water must be properly directed to protect the road.

Upper Lakeview Drive: the edges closest to Oak Ridge Road should be crack sealed. The broken asphalt should be removed and most of the road should be graveled and rolled to pack down. The grader can be used to clean the ditch lines, pulling the debris out. The skid steer would then be used to clean up and load the truck for removal. Wendall discusses the need to organize the effort from the onset. The first culvert on Upper Lakeview Drive needs a discharge pocket formed. The second culvert, near #24, need to have the pipe removed as it does not properly direct anything. The corner needs to be graveled and properly sloped to direct water into the ditch.

Old Town Road: this road needs to be properly ditched, graded and crowned.
